

Vancouver Magic Circle Trophy Lending Agreement

The Vancouver Magic Circle owns a variety of trophies, each representing a competition or award that the Circle hosts. These trophies are a reflection of the history of the Vancouver Magic Circle and are kept safe for their preservation. Members may receive keeper medals upon winning various competitions and are not entitled to the possession of the Circle's property.

This being said, upon adequately demonstrating the need for the physical possession of a trophy, the Executive Board will consider the member's request.

Any and all trophies belonging to the Vancouver Magic Circle may be lent, pending the Executive Board's authorization, to qualifying members in good standing for a period of time not exceeding 1 week unless otherwise expressly authorized by the Executive Board. Qualification to borrow trophies ultimately lies at the discretion of the Executive Board and will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis at the following Executive Meeting or at the will of the Executive Board. In order to borrow a trophy, winners must fulfill the following set of requirements that include, but is not limited to:

- winning the competition or being presented with an award for which the trophy in question represents
- demonstrate a need for the physical possession of the trophy
- be a member in good standing for the entirety of the term in which the trophy is in their possession
- take proper measures to ensure the safety and integrity of the trophy
- return the trophy at the will of the Executive

I recognize that I am required to return the trophy to the care of the Executive Board without question upon request. I accept that conduct in opposition to these regulations may result in disciplinary action and accept the consequences therein.
