CONSTITUTION UPDATES

Our Constitution states, in Article 1 (b) 1.2 under Bylaws "These Bylaws may be altered or added to at any General meeting by an extraordinary resolution.". Article 1 (b) 1.3 EXTRAORDINARY RESOLUTIONS "Notice in writing shall be duly given of intention to propose any resolution as an extraordinary resolution. Such notice shall contain a copy of the proposed resolution and shall name the date of the meeting of the Circle at which the resolution will be proposed as an extraordinary resolution. Such notice shall be given by delivering a copy thereof to the Secretary at least thirty (30) days prior to such meeting and by publication. A majority of not less than three-fourths of the members present and in good standing at such a meeting and who are entitled to vote shall be required to pass such a resolution."

The amendment proposed is to define the 2nd Vice Presidents job description, Article 5 (b) 5.3.1which currently reads "The 2nd VICE-PRESIDENT: (definition to be determined by committee)". The proposed change to Article 5 (b) 5.3.1 would be "The 2nd VICE-PRESIDENT, in absence of the President, and the first Vice-President shall preside as Chairman at all meetings of the Circle and Board of Directors. Responsibilities, duties and power vested in them at these times will be the same as if they were President. In absence of the President and Vice-Presidents, the meeting shall appoint a Chairman to preside at such meeting. The Chairman shall hold no vote during the proceedings."

This proposed change will be presented at the AGM on Thursday, January 25, 2018.

This next one is not a constitution change but the process is explained under Article 4 (b) 4.2 "The Annual Dues for an Active Member, Junior Member and Senior Member for any coming year shall be determined by the Executive and shall be published in the Circle newsletter in October each year. If no dues are published at that time then the last published rates will apply. Members who have paid their dues in advance of notification of dues increase, to a maximum of three years, will have those dues honoured until they expire, regardless of any increases. When pre-paid dues are used up, all Members will be assessed new dues for the following year(s) based on the last published rate.

At the last Executive meeting, a motion was made to "Increase dues by \$5.00 for each level of membership due to rising costs of maintaining the club activities." The Executive Board voted and it was passed unanimously. This is to notify all Members of the Vancouver Magic Circle there will be an increase, across the board, of \$5.00 to each level of membership effective for 2018 Dues.

New annual rates:
Adult \$40.00
Senior \$30.00
Junior \$30.00
Out of Town \$25.00
3 year payment is 3x yearly membership, discounted by \$15.00.
